

Information about the Bachelor's Thesis

What is a Bachelor's Thesis?

- Bachelor's theses are independent written pieces of work completed during the Bachelor's program, which must be written as part of courses.
- In the MaWiTech Bachelor's program, an independent written piece of work (Bachelor's Thesis) must be written as part of the Seminar Bachelor's Thesis – MaWiTech. The seminar is credited with 7.5 ECTS credits.

When can I start my Bachelor's thesis?

- The Bachelor's thesis can only be started after successfully completing the STEOP. It is recommended to start the thesis after finalizing all courses from the required subjects of the first to fourth semesters.

How do I get a Bachelor's thesis?

- Every chair associated with the MaWiTech program offers the Seminar Bachelor's Thesis – MaWiTech, which is credited with 7.5 ECTS credits.
- In principle, topics for Bachelor's theses can only be assigned by the responsible seminar instructors.

What MUST I keep in mind?

- Do not begin your bachelor's thesis without meeting the prerequisites!
- Decide on a specific topic.
- Contact the seminar leader responsible for that topic.
- Decide on a specific topic offered to you.
- Never begin your bachelor's thesis without the approval of a seminar leader from a materials science chair!
- Do not begin your bachelor's thesis in industry or at a department outside the materials science field without the approval of the seminar leader from a materials science chair or the program director!
- Do not begin your bachelor's thesis without registering for the Bachelor's Thesis - MaWiTech seminar at the chair of your choice!
- It is not possible to turn a internship into a bachelor's thesis (double crediting of ECTS points for internship and Seminar Bachelor's Thesis – MaWiTech)!
